

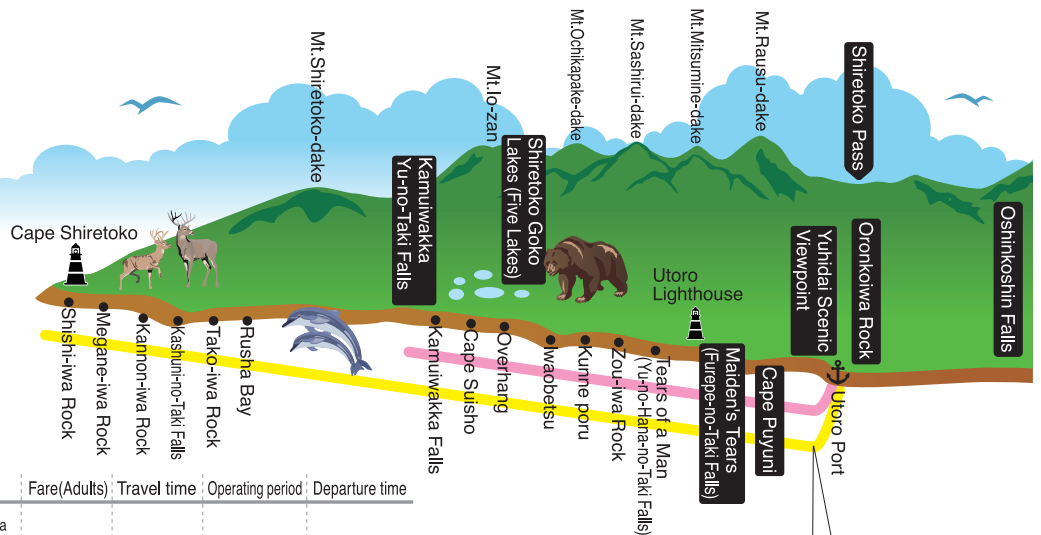

The coast of Shiretoko Peninsula consist of many precipitous cliffs, and especially on the west coast dynamic landscapes like sea cliffs, sea caves, odd-shaped rocks and falls stretch on and on. Cruising is the only possible way to access this mysterious place that is inaccessible to humans. From a boat, one can fully enjoy rough landscapes and safely observe brown bears on the shore. They will all become unforgettable memories. *There are various cruising routes that small boats take (inc. a route that provide a better chance to see brown bears on the shore from a distance).

The Shiretoko Ryuhyo Festival Winter

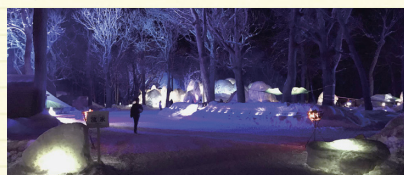

Shiretoko Shari Neputa Summer

Shiretoko Shari Neputa is a famous seasonal event in Shiretoko in summer. It started as a result of a cultural friendship exchange with a friendship city, Hirosaki in Aomori prefecture. On the fourth Friday and Saturday in July every year, more than 12 Neputa (picturesque festival floats) of various sizes are pulled through the town against the sound of big drums in the background. Among these, Neputa, which is 8 meters high and was brought from Hirosaki, is particularly spectacular.
